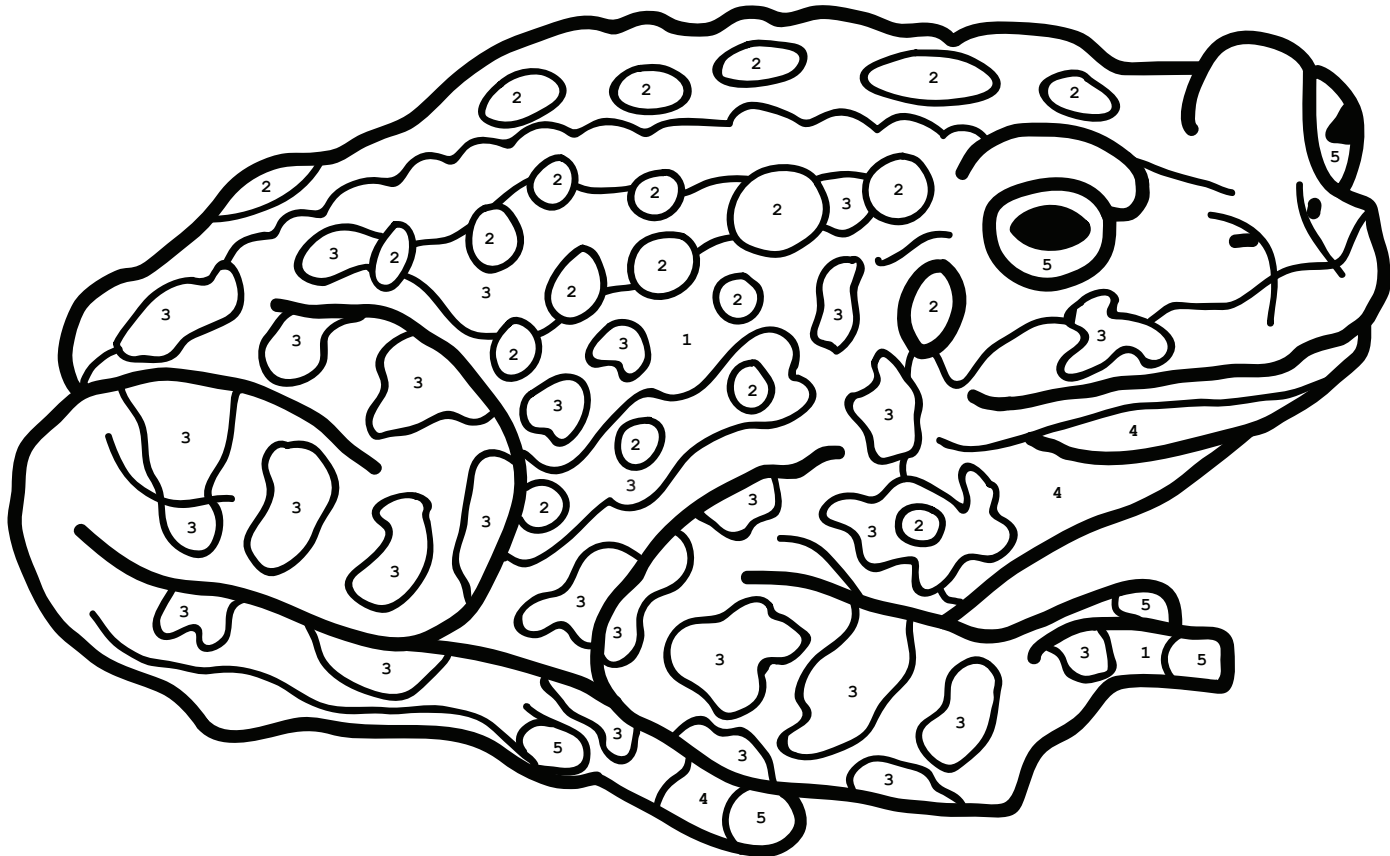


# Western Toad



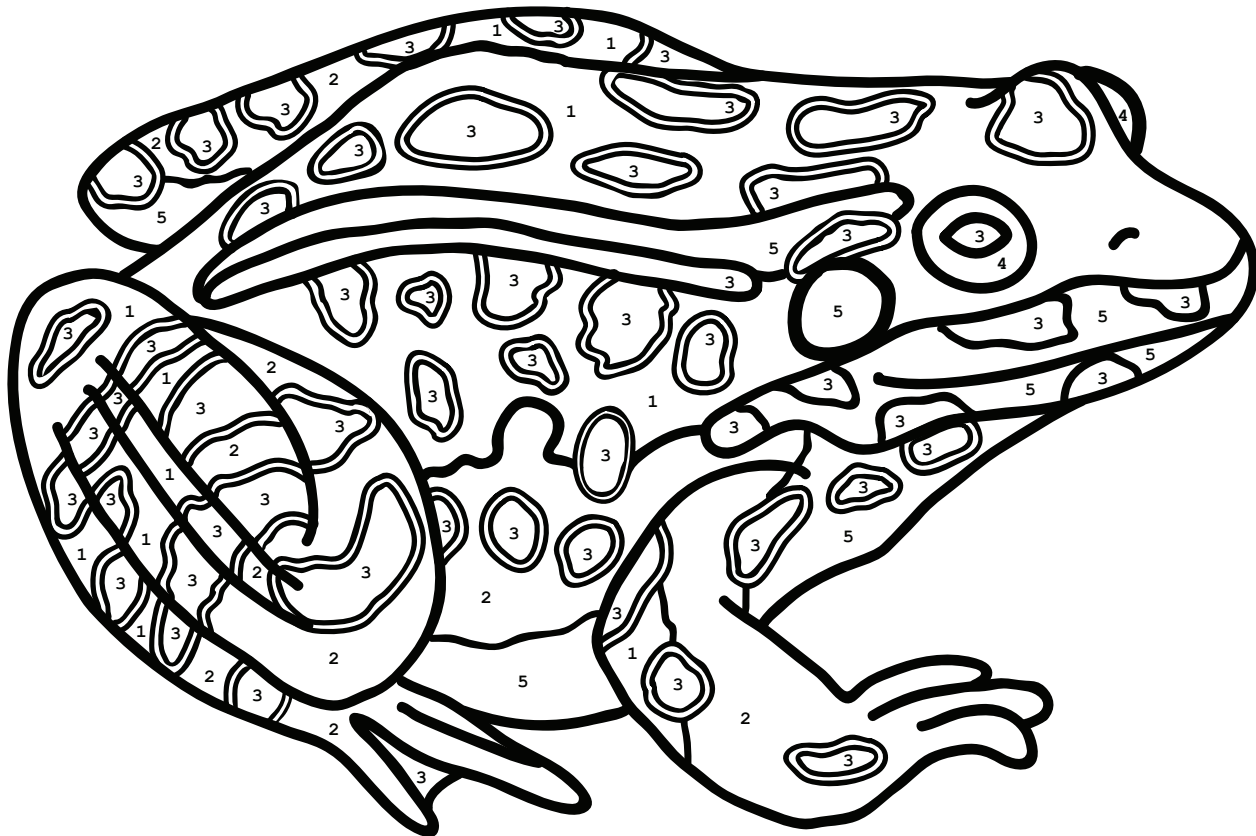
- 1 Light Green

- 3 Dark Grey or Black
- 4 Beige
- 5 Reddish Brown

Colour in the spaces to see the marking on the Western Toad! This will help you spot one in real life. They can be anywhere from green, to reddish brown to black. These toads have lots of small round bumps that look like warts. They have a light stripe down their back, the same colour as their smooth bellies.

Colour in the spaces to see the marking on the Northern Leopard Frog! This will help you spot one in real life. Their smooth skin is usually green and sometimes a little brown. There are two light stripes down the sides of their backs, the same colour as their clear bellies. They get their name from their dark spots with light borders.
